Tickets: Tickets will be sold at the door for \$10 cash by a ticket seller provided by the Hoosier Gym. The total number of tickets sold can not exceed 600. The revenue of sales will be split with the Gym and the Home Team 50/50.

Officials: The Hoosier Gym hires IHSAA officials to work the games. 3 Officials for Varsity and 2 Officials for Junior Varsity games. We only hire Officials with Tournament experience. JV Officials are paid \$70.00 and Varsity Officials are paid \$80.00 each per game. The Officials are paid out of ticket revenue before it has been split between the Gym and the Home Team.

Home Team Responsibilities: The Home Team must provide an athletic trainer, clock operator, and an announcer. May designate an Anthem singer if desired or use the Gym's recorded version.

Cheerleaders: Because of limited sideline space Cheerleaders (if attending) must remain in front row of sections B & C. Cheerleaders will be allowed on the floor for, player introductions, half-time, between quarters.

Balls: Spalding is the official ball of The Hoosier Gym. The Gym supplies the game ball for games. Teams must provide balls for warm-up.

Concessions and Memorabilia: The Hoosier Gym will sell concessions. No outside food or drink is allowed by fans in the gym. The Hoosier Gym will sell Hoosier Gym Memorabilia. No outside sales of memorabilia is allowed.

Rent: The rental fee for the Gym is \$100 per game.

Certificate of Liability Insurance: Each school must provide The Hoosier Gym with a Certificate of Liability Insurance at least one week prior to the game.
