

Conley ended his season with a total of 441 points and 238 assists and was named to the All-Big Ten First Team. Following his freshman season, he entered the 2007 NBA draft. He was the fourth overall pick in the 2007 NBA draft for the Memphis Grizzlies. He became the Grizzlies all time leader for points. In 2009, Conley became the permanent starter for the Grizzlies. He has been awarded the NBA Sportsmanship Award in 2014 and 2016. In 2016, Conley re-signed with the Grizzlies. His five-year, \$153 million deal, was the greatest contract by total value in NBA history at that point in time. He recently was traded to the Utah Jazz to play as point guard.



Vaughn Duggins began his collegiate basketball career at Wright State
University. Duggins finished his career at University as the third all-time leading scorer. Duggins is now a professional basketball player as shooting guard for EWE Baskets Oldenburg of the German BBL. On July 2, 2015, Duggins signed a 2-year contract with Oldenburg.



Devan Dumes (pictured to the left) began his collegiate basketball career at Eastern Michigan. His freshman year, he averaged 8.1 points, 2.0 rebounds, 1.6 assists and 1.0 steals for the Eagles. He then transferred to Vincennes University. He averaged a team-high 16.9 points, four rebounds and four assists and set a school record with 109 three-pointers. Dumes finished second on the team in assists with 137 and steals with 43. He was ranked as the nation's 29th-best junior college player. Dumes transferred to Indiana University and played basketball his senior year there. He played in 30 of 31 games. He was second on the team in steals (30) and 3-point shots made (31). While attending IU, he majored in General Studies.

Ryan Fultz played collegiate basketball and ran track and field at Anderson University.

J.R. Howell played collegiate basketball at Marian University. His freshman year, he played in all 25 games with three starts. During his sophomore year, he played played in all 27 games with three starts and averaged 8.1 points per game. While there, he majored in Elementary Education. He is a former basketball coach at Center Grove High School, Anderson University, and Northwood University. Howell is now the Head Basketball Coach at Caston High School.

Greg Oden (pictured to the right) began his collegiate basketball career at Ohio State University. He is a former professional basketball player. On August 26, 2015, he signed a one-year, \$1.2 million contract with Jiangsu Dragons of the Chinese basketball association. Lance Robinson played collegiate basketball at Aurora University. In his career, Robinson had 787 points, 589 rebounds, 489 assists and 203 steals. During his senior season, Robinson, averaged 13.9 points, 7.2 rebounds, and 7.2 assists per game and 1.8 steals per game. He was named the 2009-2010 Northern Athletics Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Year. He earned his bachelor's and master's degree from Aurora University in Business. Robinson joined the AU coaching staff for the 2010-2011 season as a Graduate Assistant Coach. Starting in the 2012-2013 season, Robinson remained on staff as a full-time Assistant Coach. In his second season, 2017-2018, Robinson was named the Northern Athletics Collegiate Conference Coach of the Year. 
